PURPOSE: The purpose of this Reference Guide is to inform staff working with secondary students on the Alternate Curriculum of the requirement to complete the Course of Study for Students on the Alternate Curriculum Form during the Individual Transition Plan (ITP) portion of the Individualized Education Program (IEP) team meeting.

Completing the Form fulfills a key requirement of Performance Indicator 13 of the *Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA)*.

BACKGROUND: The Course of Study Form provides a multiyear description of coursework from the student’s current year to the anticipated exit year and is designed to help the student achieve identified postsecondary goals.

The purpose of the form is future planning; therefore, it is not necessary to backfill classes a student has already taken. For example, if a student is currently in the 9th grade, it is not mandatory to fill in the electives for grades 6-8, but it is mandatory to fill in the electives for grades 9-12. The box titled “Ages 19-22: Adult Transition Activities/Program” also needs to be completed and should become more specific as the student progresses through their secondary education. The Course of Study must be discussed with the parent and student during the IEP team meeting.

MAJOR CHANGES: Not applicable.

INSTRUCTIONS: IEP teams are to use the attached Course of Study for Students on the Alternate Curriculum Form during the IEP meeting for students ages 14-22 who participate on the Alternate Curriculum.

Typical courses that students accessing the Alternate Curriculum may participate in are prepopulated in black font, but can be altered based on the individualized needs of the student.

Placeholders for elective courses are designated with blue font and need to be populated with course titles by the IEP team.

The form is a fillable WORD document and can be modified.
