INFORMATION (Continued):	 All participants must: 1. Enroll in and complete the Online BII Tracking course; 2. Pass the Online BII Tracking course quiz; 3. Print the certificate of completion and submit it to the school site administrator or administrative designee as evidence of completion.
REGISTRATION INFORMATION:	 Registration is available only through the Learning Zone. To register, complete the following steps: 1. Go online to the Learning Zone at https://lz.lausd.net. 2. Log in using your Single Sign-on (SSO) username and password (the same sign-on used for District email); 3. Click on the "Courses" tab; 4. Click on the "Class Offerings" link; 5. In the "Program" drop-down menu, select "Special Education"; 6. In the "Format" drop-down menu, select "Web-based Learning"; 7. Click on the romat" drop-down menu, select "Web-based Learning"; 7. Click on the aname of the course: "Online BII Tracking Course"; 9. Click on the "Enroll Now" button; 10. Click "OK" to confirm your enrollment. Note: You will be considered enrolled in the course upon receipt of a confirmation email sent to your LAUSD email account. The confirmation email will contain instructions for accessing the course. To access the LAUSD Learning Zone, users will need to log in using their (SSO Account) Single Sign-On username and password. <i>For LAUSD Employees</i> , this is the same as your LAUSD email username and password. If you currently don't have an SSO Account, please submit a request through the LAUSD Single Sign-On Self Service Console (https://sso.lausd.net). <i>For Non-Employees</i> (Contractors, Charter School Employees, Service Providers, etc.), use your SSO username and password, which you have acquired online through the EZ-Access Request System.
